Scholarship Criteria:

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Demonstrate a commitment to community service:
 - Current USF students must have a minimum of 20 hours of community service documented by the Office of Service and Social Action in a single academic year.
 - New USF students must submit letters from each agency documenting the hours they have volunteered with a minimum of 20 hours total.
- Essay describing how community service has impacted you personally and is enhancing your educational experience.
